- 206 Maintain and develop personal performance (2)
- 207 Establish and maintain effective working relationships with others (2)

PLUS A MINIMUM of 32 credits from the following units which must include 9 Credits
(MINIMUM of 5 units) from Group A and 15 credits from Group B

- 219 Assist with pre and post trek procedures (5)
- 220 Assist with the day to day care of performance horses (4)
- 221 Assist with care of performance horses after strenuous exercise (6)
- 222 Assist with the care of horses at competitions (6)
- 223 Prepare horses for riders with special requirements (3)
- 224 Assist with mounting and dismounting riders with special requirements (2)
- 225 Assist with riding activity for riders with special requirements (2)
- 226 Assist with receiving a horse and carrying out an initial assessment (2)
- 227 Assist with the rehabilitation of horses (3)
- 228 Load and unload animals for transportation (3)
