



KEITS Summer Newsletter 2019



Distance Learning Courses

KEITS now have a range of short distance learning courses available to employers and their staff who are over 19 years old. They are also available to people who are not employed and can be completed in as little as 8 weeks (dependant on the course). These courses are fully funded so there is no cost to the learners who are undertaking them! Applicants will have to have lived in the EU for more than 3 years to be eligible.

These courses can help people develop their career potential and improve their understanding of key areas covering Health and Social Care, Education and Business & Management (see below).

The courses are delivered using

high-quality, engaging learning content and NCFE approved assessments that are available both online and in hard copy.

The training offers a nationally recognised Level 2 qualification as well as personal and professional development for the learner.



All learners will have access to a KEITS Training & Assessment Consultant for the duration of the course and are allowed to study in their own time after an enrolment session.

Short Courses at KEITS

As well as the new distance **NPTC Level 2 Award in the Safe use of Pesticides Units PA1 & PA6** learning courses, KEITS continue to run several awards/courses at our head office including:

City & Guilds Award in Education and Training

This course is designed to give people the knowledge and confidence to teach in post 16 education.

Assessment and Quality Assurance

The City & Guilds 6317 Award in Assessment and Quality Assurance is a qualification open to people carrying out assessments and quality assurance in most learning environments.

Emergency First Aid at Work

The qualification is designed for those who need to be able to undertake Emergency First Aid in a work environment as a first line First Aider.

These units are suitable for those working in forestry, agriculture, horticulture and greenkeeping. They are based round the National Proficiency Test Council PA1 (Foundation) Test and PA6 (Hand Held Applicators) Test. and are designed to help people to successfully prepare for their tests.

In Other News..

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This will result in apprentices having different content and durations of apprenticeships. It may even prevent some individuals from being supported through an apprenticeship, who do not meet the minimum threshold of 'substantive new learning' required to fulfil the stipulated Off Job Training requirements, for the minimum duration of an apprenticeship.

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Ofsted will also be measuring RPL through their 'Quality of Education' Judgments, in the 2019 Education Inspection Framework. Inspectors will consider the provider's curriculum, which embodies the 'decisions the provider has made about the knowledge, skills & behaviours its learners need.'
