

Animal Care and Welfare Manager Careers Progression Options

Working in the sector:

Animal care is part of the environmental and land-based industries, work in this industry generally covers the health, welfare, and husbandry of animals as well as the supervision of staff.

There are approximately 120,000 people working in the industry with almost 75% of the animal care industry accounts for pet shops, pet supplies, boarding establishments and dog grooming businesses.

The sector is growing year on year with 59% of households in the UK owning a pet. Recent growth has been seen in the areas of dog boarding, pet sitting/ walking and day care.
